

ANNOUNCEMENT

<u>Advisory for Entry into the Kingdom of Thailand</u> for Non-Thai National in Urgent Need of Medical Treatment

The non-Thai nationals who are in urgent need of medical treatment at the hospitals/medical institutions in the Kingdom of Thailand may apply for entry permit through the following procedures:

1. Applicants should **submit request and relevant document from their respective Embassies/Missions/International Organizations** <u>in Thailand</u> to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand. The applications will be considered by the relevant Thai authorities on <u>a case-by-case basis</u>, taking into account <u>urgency and humanitarian reasons</u>.

2. Should the entry request be approved, the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General **will issue "Certificate of Entry" and "appropriate visa"** for the applicant (if the applicant does not have a valid visa to enter Thailand). In order to collect the "Certificate of Entry" from the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General, the applicant must **present** (1) Travel plan (Confirmed Air Ticket) (2) Copy of COVID-free Health Certificate (test negative for COVID-19 and issued no more than 72 hours before departure date) and (3) Health insurance covering all expenditures of patient transfer and medical treatment in Thailand

3. The applicant is required to present the following documents to the airline check-in counter on the departure date :

(1) **Certificate of Entry** obtained from the Royal Thai Embassy or the Royal Thai Consulate-General;

(2) Covid-free Health Certificate (test negative for COVID-19 and issued no more than 72 hours before departure)

(3) Health insurance covering all expenditures of patient transfer and medical treatment in Thailand.

4. Upon entry into the Kingdom, the applicant must submit a T.8 form upon entry into the Kingdom. Download form at https://thaiembdc.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/03/T8 form.pdf or register online through AOT phone application at https://aot-app.kdlab.ai/. In addition, the applicant is subjected to 14 - day quarantine at the hospital and obliged to comply with the Government's disease prevention measures.
