



## Revised Entry Measures into Thailand by Air travel According to Thai Ministry of Public Health

(Effective on 9 January 2023 onwards)

- VACCINATION CERTIFICATE IS NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR ALL PASSENGERS.
- PASSENGER FROM COUNTRY THAT HAS REQUIREMENT FOR RT-PCR TEST MIGHT AS WELL HAVE HEALTH INSURANCE COVERING AT LEAST USD 10,000 OF TREATMENT OF COVID-19 FOR THE ITINERARIES IN THAILAND PLUS 7 DAYS. THOSE WITH BUSINESS ARRANGEMENT, INCLUDING FLIGHT CREW, STUDENT, MAY USE A LETTER FROM THE HOST OR OTHER FORM OF INSURANCE TO COVER SUCH NEED.

ABSENCE OF HEALTH INSURANCE IS NOT THE REASON TO DENY BOARDING. IF NOT EXIST, THE PASSENGER WILL HAVE TO PURCHASE HEALTH INSURANCE BEFORE IMMIGRATION UPON ARRIVAL TO THAILAND. THE PROOF OF INSURANCE OF PASSENGER FROM RELEVANT COUNTRY WILL BE RANDOMLY CHECKED BY THE QUARANTINE OFFICER AT AIRPORT.



### **THIS DOSE NOT APPLY TO :**

- ✓ THAI PASSPORT HOLDERS.
- ✓ TRANSIT/TRANSFER PASSENGERS. HOWEVER, THEY ARE STILL SUBJECTED TO MEASURES IN PLACE AT THEIR FINAL DESTINATION.
