Ambassador of Thailand welcomed the inaugural flight of Thai Smile Airways from Bangkok to Kathmandu

Mr. Vosita Vorasaph, Ambassador of Thailand to Nepal was invited to welcome the inaugural flight WE319 of Thai Smile Airways from Bangkok to Kathmandu on 1 July 2022 at Triphuvan International Airport (TIA). Thai Smile will operate one flight daily from Bangkok – Kathmandu –Bangkok. It is expected to help boost economic activities between the Thailand and Nepal.

Thailand and Nepal has deep-rooted ties through Buddhism relations, and this mission is another part of Thailand's good will to assist Nepal in education development and strengthen cooperation between the two nations via supporting Nepal's buddhist communities.
