Ambassador handed over royal assents granted by their Majesties the King and Queen of Thailand and Her Royal Highness Princess Bajrakitiyabha Narendiradebyavati to assist the Government of Nepal in alleviating the COVID-19 situation in Nepal on 30 May 2021



On 30 May 2021, His Excellency Mr. Vosita Vorasaph, Ambassador of Thailand to Nepal, handed over the royal assents granted by His Majesty King Maha Vajiralongkorn Phra Vajiraklaochoayuhua of the Kingdom of Thailand, Her Majesty Queen Suthida Bajrasudhabimalalakshana and Her Royal Highness Princess Bajrakitiyabha Narendiradebyavati to the Government of Nepal and her people through Mr. Hridayesh Tripathi, the then Minister of Health and Population, in support of Nepal's efforts to alleviate the current outbreak of COVID-19 in the country. In addition, Honorable Mr. Pradip Kumar

Gyawali, the then Minister of Foreign Affairs and Honorable Mr. Krishna Gopal Shrestha, Minister for Education, Science and Technology, were also present at the handover ceremony. The said royal assents consisted of medical equipments and were delivered to Kathmandu, Nepal by the special flight of the Royal Thai Air Force on 30 May 2021. Earlier, on 14 and 28 May 2021, Thailand donated altogether 63 oxygen concentrators to Nepal, reflecting Thailand's continued efforts to assist Nepal and bring our two peoples closer in preventing and combating the spread of COVID-19 together.

On 20 and 24 May 2021, H.E. Mr. Vosita Vorasaph, Ambassador of Thailand to Nepal and the Embassy's team visited Thai community in Kathmandu Valley. On the same occasion, H.E. conference to ask Thai community about their living conditions.



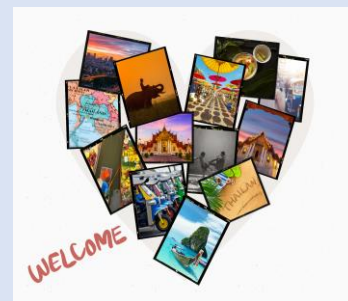
Ambassador attended the online ceremony to celebrate the Vesak Day
