### Auction of Embassy's vehicle

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The Royal Thai Embassy wishes to announce an auction of the Embassy's vehicle as follows:

1. Vehicle: Honda Odyssey EX-L (NAV), Year 2012, Black color, 3,500 cc, 7-passenger seating (see attachment)
2. Mileage 110,395 miles
3. Minimum offer: \$10,000
4. The auction will be conducted on 14 March 2024 during 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m. Written bids must be submitted to the Embassy no later than 09.00 a.m. of 14 March 2024
5. The auction will take place at the Royal Thai Embassy, 1024 Wisconsin Ave. N.W., Washington, D.C. 20007.
6. The vehicle shall be sold at its present condition. The bidder must read the auction announcement and check the conditions of the vehicle prior to the auction. Once the bidder decides to take part in the auction, the bidder has agreed to and accept the conditions of the auction. The bidder cannot request the Embassy to adjust, change, or repair the vehicle to improve its condition.
7. The bidder must offer the price not less than the minimum price set by the Embassy. The highest bidder is eligible to purchase the vehicle and must immediately pay the full price or place a deposit not less than 40 percent of the auctioned price to the Finance Section of the Embassy with proof of identification. The Embassy will issue the receipt and the bidder must pay the residual amount within 5 working days of the auction date and may collect the vehicle from the Embassy once necessary procedure is completed.
8. The buyer shall be responsible for the transfer fee, license plate fee, transportation cost, taxes and any other related expenses.
9. If the winning bidder fails to pay for the outstanding of balance the vehicle within the deadline, the bidder will be deemed to have relinquished the bid and shall not be entitled to ask the Embassy for any compensation.
10. A bidder must not have conflict of interest with other bidders nor obstruct a fair competition in this bidding.
11. The committee members of this can neither take part in this auction nor use another party to take part on their behalf.

3. Offers must arrive no later than 09.00 a.m. on 14 march 2024.
4. The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any offer less than minimum bid.
5. It is assumed that bidders are satisfied and accept the present condition of the vehicle, and the Embassy assumes no responsibility for any changes or repairs to the vehicle.
6. The Committee will consider the highest and acceptable bidding amount, which must not be less than the minimum offer set by the Committee, to be the winner.
7. Once a winning bidder is announced, he/she shall be notified and requested by the Committee to immediately pay a 40 percent non-refundable deposit. The remaining balance shall be paid in full amount within 5 working days of the auction date. If the balance is not settled within the due date, the Embassy will assume that the bidder renounces his/her own right and a new auction will be conducted accordingly.
8. Upon the receipt of the deposit, a receipt will be issued by the Embassy. Afterward, the Embassy will coordinate with the Department of the state, to request for the vehicle's title.
