on Payment Methods at the Visa Section

Starting from 9 June 2021, the visa section of the Royal Thai Embassy in Nairobi will be receiving fees **in Kenyan Shilling** for its services; namely visa, legalization, and Thai passport through the following 3 methods.

1. **Cash** to be paid at the counters
2. **M-Pesa** (Kenyan mobile banking system)
