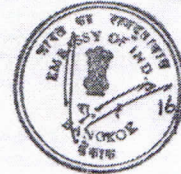
The Embassy of India, Bangkok presents its compliments to the Thailand International Cooperation Agency of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand and has the honour to inform that Indian Railways, in collaboration with Asian Institute of Transport Development have taken several initiatives in support of Government's Act East Policy, including launching regional training programme for the countries from South and South-East Asia. The training programme for railway managers in the region was started in the year 2005. Till date, 26 courses have been held providing technical, operational and financial training in specialized subjects to more than 500 managers from the railway system of South and South-East Asian countries.

The 27th training course has been scheduled from 14 to 30 March 2020. It will focus on the subject "Resource Mobilisation and Financial Management in the Railways". The academic contents of the course will be imparted at National Academic of India Railways (NAIR) Vadodara followed by field training at New Delhi. While at Vadodara, a weekend technical visit to Mumbai is also planned. A visit to Agra would be arranged at the conclusion of the course. The training as well as board and lodging of course participants would be provided free of cost to the participants. Same would be the case with regard to their inland travel within India. The participants will, however be expected to bear their personal out-of-pocket expenses.

The esteemed Ministry is requested to nominate two participants with appropriate experience and promise of their active involvement in the subject in future.
