

Course Outline International Training Course

1. Course Title:

Sexually Transmitted Infections Case Management Skills

2. Duration:

19 – 30 September 2022 (10 Working days)

3. Background and Rational:

Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs) or more recently referred to as sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) are a major global cause of acute illness, infertility, long-term disability and death, with severe medical and psychological consequences for millions of men, women and infants. STIs have a profound impact on sexual and reproductive health worldwide. More than one million STIs are acquired every day. Each year, there are estimated 357 million new infections with 1 of 4 STIs: chlamydia (131 million), gonorrhea (78 million), syphilis (5.6 million) and trichomoniasis (143 million). Failure to diagnose and treat STIs may result in serious complications and sequelae which include pelvic inflammatory diseases, infertility, ectopic pregnancy, fetal wastage and neonatal and childhood infections and HIV/AIDS.

STIs are a hidden epidemic and usually neglected in developing countries due to many constraints such as lack of STIs case management skills and facilities, self-treatment of STIs clients, underreport cases, etc. Screening and treatment of STIs have multi-prong benefits and should play a more prominent role because untreated STIs increase the likelihood of contracting and passing on HIV, the virus that causes AIDS.

Division of AIDS and STIs, Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health has accumulated experience and expertise in professionals from the Asian countries since 1977. Its training curriculum and faculty have been well accepted by international agencies which regularly provide funding support for related health personnel to be trained.

4. Objectives:

Overall Goal: To articulate the updated knowledge on STIs to health professionals (participants). Including the development of potential and skills necessary for STIs case

management, adaptation of innovation for treatment and care, and modifying the example of operational guidelines to suit the context of another country through the demonstration process, knowledge sharing, and site visits on the interesting health service units.

Objectives of the training:

- Participating AIDS/STIs health professionals are equipped with the understanding of the concept and important issues of STIs case management approaches.
- Trained participants increase knowledge and skills to be able to make correct, timely and efficiently diagnosis and treatment of STIs.
- Trained participants are followed up after the training to ensure their better skills and application at their workplace.
- Experiences and lessons learned on STIs case management approaches are shared among participants.

5. Course Contents:

- Module 1: Course Introduction and Overview of STIs/HIV
- Module 2: Concept of making STIs diagnosis with demonstration
- Module 3: Urethral symptoms and scrotal swelling approach and management
- Module 4: Genital ulcer and inguinal bubo approach and management
- Module 5: Syphilis (Management of syphilis)
- Module 6: Genital lesion approach and management
- Module 7: STIs Laboratory and demonstration
- Module 8: STIs Health Education, Counseling and partner notification
- Module 9: Clinical practice (Clinical and side room lab experience: Male/Female clinic
- Module 10. Prevention and controls of STI in adolescent MSM and sex workers
- Module 11: Site visit

6. Participants Criteria:

Applicants must fulfill the following requirement:

- Be nominated by their respective government.
- Be university graduate or equivalent in medical, nursing fields, public health fields, science field.
- Be persons who are engaged in STIs treatment and care, with at least two (2) years working experience in STIs or related fields.
- Be under fifty (50) years of age.
- Have good command of spoken and written English.
- Be in good health both physically and mentally; a health certificate certified by an authorized physician is required for each participant.
- This medical report form is attached to the Nomination form.
- Expect to continue working in the HIV/STIs treatment and care program after finishing this course.

7. Attendance and Evaluation

At the end of this training course, participants will be required to evaluate the overall training in terms of the session usefulness, materials, and the information and knowledge gained. Recommendations and suggestions on the training curriculum will be needed. All participants with at least 80% of training attendance will be given a certificate of attendance.
