3. Background and Rational:

TICA: Thailand International Cooperation Agency

As an approach and mind setting framework, we believe that SEP can be applied to all 17 SDGs. Therefore, over the recent years, Thailand has shared with international community the application of SEP, our home-grown approach to sustainable development.

4. Objectives:

This Online training course aims at sharing Thailand's experiences in applying Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) to community sustainable development. At the end of this course, participants are expected to;

- Understand the community development mechanism guiding to self-reliance
- Understand the concepts of Sufficiency Economy Philosophy
