NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (“RFI”) FOR MRT3 CIRCLE LINE PROJECT

The Government of Malaysia has appointed MASS RAPID TRANSIT CORPORATION SDN BHD (902884V) (MRT Corp.) as the MRT Project Developer and Asset Owner for the delivery of a fully commissioned metro rail system known as “PROJEK MASS RAPID TRANSIT LALUAN 3: LALUAN LINGKARAN”.

PROJEK MASS RAPID TRANSIT LALUAN 3: LALUAN LINGKARAN (“MRT3 Circle Line”) is part of the Greater Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley Land Transport Masterplan and will interchange existing radial railway lines in Klang Valley. Its function is to distribute passengers throughout existing KL transit systems and acts as terminal nodes and promotes green mobility in Kuala Lumpur City Centre.

Preceding to the above subject matter, MRT Corp. is in the process of gathering information and responses from interested companies via a Request for Information (RFI) exercise. This exercise will allow MRT Corp to fully consider all potential participants (“Participants”) of this project and review the interest, capacity, and capability of the industry to participate in any future tender exercise relating to this project.

A briefing session (RFI Briefing) will be held for interested parties who meet the compulsory requirements and Participants will be required to pre-register to attend this briefing. Details of the RFI briefing session is provided below.

Please be advised that this is NOT an invitation to bid but strictly a ‘Request for Information’ exercise. Neither this request nor your reply or submission constitutes any commitment on our behalf to include you in any future tender exercises.

La Ley Ómnibus (GR 365/2021) de Indonesia supone cambios significativos para los trabajadores subcontratados, las horas de trabajo y el procedimiento para la terminación del empleo. La GR 365/2021 es una regulación importante, puesto que se espera que con ella se consiga una mayor protección para los trabajadores. A este respecto, reconoce tres tipos de contratos de duración determinada (FTC):

- FTC basado en la finalización del trabajo.
- FTC según el período de tiempo
- FTC relacionado con el trabajo no permanente.
