





ECER: Population Growth by State (2005-2020)










ECER: GDP Growth Rate by State (2005-2020)













GDP growth rate in ECER has to be higher than the national GDP growth rate to correct imbalance

ECER: GDP per Capita by State (2005-2020)











GDP per capita is expected to increase significantly by RM7,650




ECER: Major Sectors GDP by State (2005-2020)












Services,* Manufacturing and Agriculture sectors are the principal sources of growth
