




ECER: Infrastructure Overview and Challenges



- ECER has adequate electricity supply to meet the projected demand until 2020
- Water supply capacity in ECER is sufficient except for Kelantan where it needs to be enhanced to meet demands
- ECER is well served by fixed line communication facilities and able to meet projected demand until 2020. However, the rate of penetration for Cellular Lines, Internet Dial Up and Broadband in the region is lower than the national standard and needs to be upgraded
- Sewerage services in the ECER need to be upgraded in stages to meet the development requirements

ECER: Infrastructure - Flood Mitigation






The recurrence of floods during the monsoon season remains a challenge in the ECER. Construction of Lebir Dam in Kuala Krai, Kelantan is one of the key projects to alleviate the situation.

ECER: Incentives (1/2)



Objectives:

- To turn the ECER into an attractive investment destination that is cost-competitive
- o To promote the ECER into a vibrant business hub
- o To encourage growth in economic activities through pro-business environment
- o To promote entrepreneurship

Incentives alone are not sufficient. It must be packaged together with improvements in transportation networks, logistics, infrastructure and other enablers.

ECER: Implementation of Plan is through Special Purpose Vehicle



The "East Coast Economic Region Development Council" will be established to drive the implementation of the ECER Master Plan

ECER: Council Members



- Members of the Council
 - Prime Minister (Chairman)
 - Deputy Prime Minister (Alternate Chairman)
 - Menteri Besar of Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang and Johor
 - Two (2) Federal Ministers
 - One (1) Civil Service Representative
 - Two (2) Private Sector Individuals

ECER: Objective of the Council



- 1. To stimulate, promote and accelerate the growth of ECER in equitable and sustainable manner;
- 2. To stimulate, promote and accelerate the development of ECER into a world class economic region and a choice destination for investment, work and living; and
- 3. To ensure that social development are kept as priorities whilst driving economic growth in ECER

ECER: Functions of the Council (1/2)



- Establishes policies, direction and strategies in relation to the development of ECER
- Acts as principal co-ordinating agent or authorised agent on behalf of Government Entities in the ECER to receive, process and expedite Approvals for trade, investment and development in the ECER
- Promotes and stimulates the ECER as a trade, investment and tourist destination
- Promotes, stimulates and facilitate tourism, infrastructure, agricultural, industrial and commercial development


ECER: Functions of the Council (2/2)



- Promotes economic and social development
- Promotes private sector investment
- Recommends to the relevant Government Entities policies, laws and actions to be applied to the ECER in furtherance of the objects of the Council
- Recommends to the relevant Government Entities incentives on taxes, customs and excise duties and other fiscal incentives for investors
