



## ANNOUNCEMENT

The Royal Thai Consulate-General, Kota Bharu wishes to inform that according to the Restriction of Movement Order under the Prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases Act 1988 and the Police Act 1967 announced by the Prime Minister of Malaysia to be effective on 18 – 31 March 2020, the Royal Thai Consulate-General will take the following actions:-

1. Temporarily suspend its Consular services (issuances of Thai passport, legalization, and visa) from 18 March 2020 until further notice. In case of emergency, please contact the Royal Thai Consulate-General's hotline number 019 667 5266.

2. The Royal Thai Consulate-General is gathering information concerning Thai citizens living in Malaysia for its official use in providing them necessary assistance in emergency situation, and urges Thai citizens living in Malaysia to do the online registration at <http://forms.gle/LcBIGCunDrMDQLYn7>

3. In case of travelling back to Thailand through immigration checkpoints in Narathiwat province namely 1) Sungai-Kolok 2) Takbai 3) Buketa, please strictly follow all the required immigration and health screening procedures. During 18 - 31 March 2020, Thai citizens can still go out of Malaysia to Thailand, but cannot return to Malaysia until 1 April 2020.
