Terms of Service

For in-person consular services (Passport, Thai Identification card, Marriage and Divorce), an <u>appointment</u> must be made in advance the following procedures abided by:

- 1. On the appointment day, if the customer has a fever with body temperature of 99.5 F, or have one of the following symptoms: cough, runny nose, sore throat, or breathing difficulties, please stay home and contact our Consulate officials to postpone the appointment.
- 2. The customer shall have ready documents, fees, and complete all required forms before the appointment. As well, the customer shall bring his/her own pen to minimize physical contacts with Consulate officials and other individuals.
- 3. In compliance with the guidelines on capacity limits, the customer shall arrive on the appointment time and ask any accompanying persons, not including those who are required to be present at the service, to wait in public areas outside the Consulate's building.
- 4. If deemed necessary, Consulate officials may measure the customer's body temperature as well as observe the customer's conditions. If it appears that the customer has a fever with body temperature of 99.5 F, or have one of the following symptoms, cough, runny nose, sore throat, or breathing difficulties, the appointment may be postponed.
- 5. The customer must wear a face mask at all times and wash his/her hands with soap or hand sanitizer before and after services.
- 6. The customer shall practice social distancing and strictly comply with Consulate officials' guidances.
- 7. The Consulate shall keep a log of the customer's name and contact information for a certain period after service to facilitate contact tracing in case a customer or an official is diagnosed with COVID-19
