INSTRUMENT OF RATIFICATION

WHEREAS the International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance was signed by the duly authorised representative of the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand on 9 January 2012;

WHEREAS Article 38, paragraph 2, of the Convention stipulates that this Convention is subject to ratification, and that the instruments of ratification shall be deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations; and

WHEREAS Article 42, paragraph 2, of the Convention stipulates that a State may, at the time of signature or ratification of this Convention or accession thereto, declare that it does not consider itself bound by paragraph 1 of this article, and that the other States Parties shall not be bound by paragraph 1 of this article with respect to any State Party having made such a declaration;

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND,

having considered the aforesaid Convention, hereby confirms and ratifies the same and undertakes to faithfully perform and carry out all the stipulations therein contained, and further declares that, in accordance with paragraph 2 of Article 42 of the Convention, the Kingdom of Thailand does not consider itself bound by paragraph 1 of Article 42 of the Convention.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Instrument of Ratification is signed and sealed by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand.

DONE at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Bangkok, this 26th day of April in the Year Two thousand Five hundred and Sixty-seven of the Buddhist Era, corresponding to the Year Two thousand and Twenty-four of the Christian Era.
