The guideline for filling in applicants name in the e-Visa application

1. Applicants have to fill in their names according MRZ codes to the ones indicate which are the two lines at the bottom of the passport data page as shown at the example below:

Caution:

1.1 if your name provides Umlauts (e.g., Ä, Ö, Ü)


You need to replace it by their Romanized equivalents (e.g., $\ddot{A} \rightarrow AE$, $\ddot{O} \rightarrow OE$, $\ddot{U} \rightarrow UE$) as it shows on your MRZ code as example below

1.2 Don't mistake between Number and Alphabet

For example, 0 [zero] and O ["O"scar]

8 [eight] and B ["B"ravo]

5 [five] and S ["S"iera]



Use the information of name and surname in red box to fill in your visa application

- 2. For nationality which doesn't have a "Family name" must fill in the entire name in the "First name" box in the e-Visa application form and leave "Family name" box blank.
- 3. Do not fill in N/A.
- 4. Do not fill in any symbols (-, ., /, @).

Failure to do so will result in the rejection of your e-Visa application because we cannot edit any of your information, the fees which applicant charges will not be refunded.
