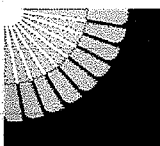
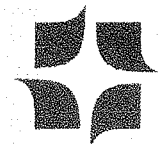

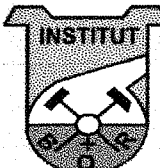

Dear Sir,

The Symposium with international participation „MINING 2015“ can contribute to development of the Serbian mining sector in the coming period.
