Recommendation Letter (In the case of a family member legally working or studying in Thailand)	The letter must be addressed to the "Royal Thai Consulate-General, Osaka", indicating the applicant's name, the purpose of visit, date of entry, length of stay, name of a family member, relationship, position in the company, monthly salary of a family member legally working in Thailand, signed by the authorized person, and has a company seal.
