

## Non-Immigrant (OA) Long Stay Visa

Overview	Duration of visa
Applicants aged 50 years and over who wish to stay in Thailand for a period not exceeding 1 year without the intention of working	1 year

Validity of visa	Visa fee
Multiple 1 year from issue date	26,000 yen
※Visa fees must be paid by e-payment of the e-Visa system using a credit card (Visa or Master Card) only. The visa application fee is non-refundable.	

Required documents	
The following documents must be uploaded in large and clear JPEG and PDF formats. (The file size must not exceed 3MB)	
1.	Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document
2.	Photograph taken within the last six months
3.	Proof of <b>permanent residence</b> in the country where the application is submitted : - Please submit a family registration (戸籍謄本) issued within three months for Japanese nationality. - Please submit a certificate of residence (住民票) issued within three months or a copy of the residence card for non-Japanese nationality.
4.	Financial evidence: An income certificate indicating a monthly income of at least 65,000 THB or bank statements for the past three months showing a balance of no less than 800,000 THB issued within one month.
5.	A medical certificate issued in the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases as specified in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E. 2535), issued within three months.
6.	Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed, and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded as follows. <a href="https://longstay.tgia.org">https://longstay.tgia.org</a>
7.	Health insurance issued by a Thai or foreign insurer for general illnesses, including COVID-19, with the insured sum of no less than 100,000 USD or 3,000,000 THB
8.	A criminal record clearance certificate issued within the past three months, from either the applicant's country of nationality or country of residence.
