1	Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document
2	Photographs taken within the last six months
3	Document indicating current location: 3.1 For Japanese: A driver's license or My Number Card For non-Japanese: A residence card that is valid for at least three months 3.2 E-Ticket itinerary
4	Financial evidence: Bank statements for the past three months showing a balance of no less than 500,000 THB issued within one month
