Discontinuation of Thai Visa Issuance by the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate - General in Amsterdam

The Regulation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Governing the Appointment and Functions of Honorary Consular Officers of the Kingdom of Thailand B.E. 2563 (2020) has entered into force on 28 May 2020. Under Article 30 of the said Regulation, which will consequently enter into force on 28 May 2021, stipulates that honorary consular officers are prohibited from issuing visas to foreigners to enter the Kingdom of Thailand, as well as from legalising any documents in the name of the honorary consular officers of the Kingdom of Thailand,

In this connection, the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate - General in Amsterdam will no longer have the authority to issue Thai visas as from 28 May 2021 onward.
