## PHUKET SANDBOX

#### 1. What is Phuket Sandbox?

• A tourism-promotion scheme that allows fully vaccinated travellers to enter Phuket, Thailand, **without quarantine**, subject to conditions below.

### 2. Eligible travellers

- Have a valid Thai visa or re-entry permit or be eligible to enter Thailand under the Tourist Visa Exemption (for more information on the Tourist Visa Exemption, please refer to <u>https://tinyurl.com/visaexemption</u>) or eligible to apply for the Visa on Arrival (VOA). Travellers who need a visa to enter Thailand have to contact the Royal Thai Embassy, Bucharest via <u>visa.BUH@mfa.mail.go.th</u> to apply for a visa before proceeding with the Certificate of Entry (COE) application.
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with a vaccine approved by World Health Organization (WHO) or Ministry of Public Health of Thailand no less than 14 days before departure. Travellers must show Certificate of Vaccination issued by a government authority. <u>Certificate of Vaccination without</u> English language will not be accepted.
  - The following vaccines are accepted
    - 1. CoronaVac by Sinovac (2 doses needed)
    - 2. AstraZeneca by AstraZeneca (2 doses needed)
    - 3. AstraZeneca by SK BIOSCIENCE (Korea) (2 doses needed)
    - 4. AstraZeneca by Siam Bioscience (2 doses needed)
    - 5. AstraZeneca by Serum Institute of India (2 doses needed)
    - 6. Janssen by Johnson & Johnson Services, Inc. (1 dose needed)
    - 7. Pfizer-BioNTECH COVID-19 vaccine by Pfizer Inc. (2 doses needed)
    - 8. Moderna by Moderna Inc. (2 doses needed)
    - 9. COVILO by Sinopharm Co., Ltd. (2 doses needed)
    - 10. Sputnik V by Gamaleya Research Institute of Epidemiology and Microbiology (2 doses needed)

- The vaccine certificate/card **must be issued by a government authority** either in digital or paper format (document issued by private entities will not be accepted). The vaccine certificate must contain the following information:
  - 1. The travellers' personal details, including name, date of birth, nationality and passport number.
  - 2. Vaccination information, including dates of vaccination (<u>the date of</u> receiving the first dose, the last dose must be administered no less than 14 days before travelling), name and lot/batch number of the vaccine.
- **Combination of different vaccines** is accepted provided that the period between the 1st and 2nd dose was in accordance with the period set by the manufacture of the first dose.
- Children <u>under the age of 18</u>, travelling with parents, are eligible <u>without</u> proof of vaccination. If they travel without their parents or legal guardians, they have to be fully vaccinated.
- Must have **health insurance** which covers treatment and medical expenses in relation to COVID-19, with a minimum coverage of 100,000 USD.
- Both non-Thais and Thais are eligible.

# 3. Conditions

## • Hotels

- Must stay at a hotel that meets the "SHA+" standard for <u>at least 7 nights</u>, unless travellers have proof of return tickets leaving Phuket (to another country which they are eligible to enter) before 7 days.
  - Those arriving in Phuket between 18.01 00.00 hrs. will need to stay for 8 nights (the day of arrival is counted as "Day Zero").
  - Those arriving in Phuket between 00.01 18.00 hrs. will need to stay for 7 nights (the day of arrival is counted as "Day One").

Travellers can choose to stay in a SHA+ hotel in Phuket, Phang-nga, or Krabi, however, they are required to stay in the same hotel for the first 7 nights.

 Confirmation of "SHA+" hotel booking must be issued under the SHABA system (SHA Plus Booking Authentication system) or booking under <u>http://entrythailand.go.th/</u>. Booking confirmation through agents will not be accepted. List of SHA+ hotels can be accessed via <u>https://www.thailandsha.com</u> or <u>https://shathailand.com</u>

• After 7 days, they may travel to other parts of Thailand. Departure earlier than 7 days is possible only for destinations outside of Thailand.

### • Transport

- Must enter Thailand via Phuket International Airport.
- From Phuket International Airport, travellers must travel to their SHA+ hotels in pre-booked cars provided by the SHA+ hotels.

### • COVID-19 tests

- Travellers must present **RT-PCR negative test result** issued no more than 72 hours <u>before departure.</u>
- Upon entry, travellers will have to undergo two tests at different times, at the traveller's own expenses. The first test will be done upon arrival; travellers will be allowed outside of their hotel rooms <u>only upon</u> <u>confirmation</u> of negative result of the first test.
- Children under the age of 6 are allowed to undergo saliva-sampled test.
- To apply for COE, travellers must submit evidence of pre-payment for the required RT-PCR tests. The tests have to be booked via https://www.thailandpsas.com/

### • Journey-tracing application

 Travellers must install <u>and use</u> journey-tracing application as instructed by the Thai Government throughout the 7 days in the Sandbox, otherwise they may not be allowed to leave the Sandbox to other parts of Thailand after 7 days. Travellers must provide proof of 7 days of stay in the Sandbox (Release Form) and 2 RT-PCR test results

### 4. How to apply for COE

 Travellers under "Phuket Sandbox" programme must apply for a Certificate of Entry (COE), like all other travellers, via <u>https://coethailand.mfa.go.th/</u>.
Please choose option "Sandbox Programme", and then select "Phuket" as Sandbox destination when completing the "travel details" column. They can apply for COE <u>up to 30 days</u> in advance.

# 5. Requirements for 'Phuket Sandbox' visitors who wish to apply for a 'Visa on Arrival' (VOA)

- Ensure that you have an approved 'Certificate of Entry' (COE) before flying to Thailand (printed version required). You can apply for the COE for Visa on Arrival via https://coethailand.mfa.go.th: choose the Type of 11 (Exempt) - Visa Exemption.

- Download the mobile application upon arrival.

- Be prepared to have all documents checked at the 'Health Control' at Phuket International Airport.

- When applying for the 'Visa on Arrival':

(1) Fill out the Application Form provided

(2) Ensure that your Passport is valid for at least 30 days

(3) Have a confirmed return flight ticket

(4) A 'SHABA' confirmation of a 'SHA Plus' hotel for a minimum of seven (7) days

(5) Two (2) passport-size photos without hats/caps or sunglasses

(6) Show that you are carrying Ten Thousand (10,000) Baht (Twenty Thousand (20,000) for a family) in any currency

(7) Two Thousand (2,000) Baht for the 'Visa Application Fee'

#### \*\* Please note that VOA will be granted for only fifteen (15) days, and it cannot be extended\*\*

- Clear the 'Immigration' process.

- Proceed to the Baggage Hall and collect luggages.

- Proceed to 'Customs'.

- Proceed outside the Terminal to the compulsory 'RT-PCR' Covid-19 test station.

- Depart to your SHA Plus hotel with a 'SHA Plus' pre-booked transportation (directly with no enroute stops).

- Check In to your SHA Plus hotel and wait in your hotel to receive 'negative' RT-PCR test results before enjoying your stay in Phuket.
