## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR TOURIST VISA

Visa applications shall be accepted with prior confirmed appointment only. To make an appointment, please send an email to: <a href="mailto:visa.BUH@mfa.mail.go.th">visa.BUH@mfa.mail.go.th</a>. Applicants will receive a confirmation email with date and time of the appointment. Applications WITHOUT appointment will not be accepted.

Please be informed that the Consular Section only opens on Wednesdays and Fridays from 09.30-12.00 hrs. The Royal Thai Embassy, Bucharest will be closed on Romanian and Thai national holidays (see the list on our website).

Due to a large number of visa applications, applicants are advised to start the visa application process at least 21 days before their departure date.

The following information is subject to change without prior notice.

## **Tourist Visa (Single Entry)**

**Validity:** 90 days from the date of issue. Travellers must enter Thailand within the validity of visa.

**Permitted length of stay:** 60 days from the date of arrival in Thailand. Travellers should carefully check the immigration stamps in their passports regarding the exact length of stay to ensure that they do not overstay their visa. *Please note that, once you leave Thailand, the visa is considered being used even if you only spend one day in Thailand.* 

**Extension of Stay:** Those who wish to stay longer or may wish to change their type of visa must file an application for permission at the Office of Immigration Bureau (http://www.immigration.go.th). The extension of stay as well as the change of certain type of visa is solely at the discretion of the Immigration officer.

## **List of required documents:**

- 1. Visa Application form (from the Embassy's website: www.thaiembassy.org/bucharest)
- 2. Original passport plus a copy (main information page) with validity of more than 6 months; copies of the previous Thai visas, if any, together with stamps of entry/exit on/from Thailand
- 3. Copy of Romanian / Bulgarian ID / residence card
- 4. Two recent passport photos
- 5. A fully paid flight ticket entering and leaving Thailand within 90 days period in English

6. Health insurance for the entire period of stay with a minimum coverage of 50,000 USD of medical costs incurred by the applicant in Thailand. The insurance must be in English and must cover the whole duration of stay in Thailand. (Any International Insurance Company or one of the Thai companies on <a href="https://covid19.tgia.org/">https://covid19.tgia.org/</a>)

Health insurance in Romanian/Bulgarian showing coverage in RON/BGN is not accepted

- 7. Vaccination certificate (EU Digital Certificate or equivalent) and a vaccination certificate which specifies the date when you received the first dose of vaccine (if any)
- 8. Employment certificate in English or with an official English translation. The employment certificate must specify salary, position, type number, and date of contract. Proof of monthly income and evidence of freelancer/company ownership can be used as a substitute
- 9. Proof of finance copy of bank statement to date showing a minimum of 30 Euro/day/adult for the entire period of stay, but not less than 1,000 Euro for a stay of up to 30 days
- 10. Accommodation booking confirmation in English according to the entry requirements of Thailand. \*\*Please be advised that accommodation booking made through Booking.com is NOT accepted even if it is marked PAID. The Thai authorities only accept pre-paid booking through Agoda or direct booking confirmation from the hotel. A letter of confirmation must specify names of guests, details of the package which includes the RT-PCR test, and prepayment confirmation.

\*\*\*For Phuket Sandbox Programme, RT-PCR tests can be booked through www.thailandpsas.com.

\*\*\*\*\*Unvaccinated children under 12 years old travelling with fully vaccinated parent(s) or guardian will be quarantined for the same period applicable to their parent(s) or guardian. Unvaccinated children from 12 years old to under 18 years old travelling with fully vaccinated parent(s) or guardian may enter Thailand under the Sandbox Programmes with their parent(s). Unvaccinated children from 18 years old must stay in quarantine for no less than 10 days.

- 11. Accommodation for the entire period of stay after Test & Go Programme / Sandbox Programmes / Quarantine e.g. hotel booking, invitation letter from family or friend in Thailand. An invitation letter must include a copy of ID card and a house registration of the host or an accommodation rental contract.

After obtaining the visa, travellers have to register for THAILAND PASS (https://tp.consular.go.th) and they will need to show a QR Code generated through the Thailand Pass system upon check-in and arrival in Thailand. The registration should be done at least 7 days before departure.

Apart from THAILAND PASS, travellers need to present a Medical certificate, in English, with a laboratory result (issued no more than 72 hours before the depart date) indicating that COVID -19 is not detected. The testing method should only be "Realtime PCR".

## Warning

Applicants shall be responsible for the information given in the application form as well as the submitted documents. Any false or misleading information, or false supporting documents, may result in the refusal of a visa application without the right of appeal.

The Royal Thai Embassy, Bucharest reserves the right to reject visa applications with incomplete/incorrect documents, applicants who have stayed in Thailand for more than 90 days within the last 6 months preceding the date of applying, applicants who overstayed or engaged in visa running and/or other illegal activities.
