^{**** &}lt;u>Sandbox areas</u> include, among others, **Bangkok**, **Phuket**, **Krabi**, **Phang-Nga**, **Surat Thani** (*Koh Samui*, *Koh Phangan*, *Koh Tao*) and **Chonburi** (*certain districts only*). Sandbox travellers must arrive **through international airports** at Suvarnabhumi, Don Mueang, Chiang Mai, Phuket, Samui, U-Tapao or Buriram (chartered flights only). At present, domestic flight transit to Sandbox areas via Bangkok is only possible for Samui (through designated flights only).

From 1 November 2021

• Removal of Quarantine Requirement

- o Travellers from <u>eligible areas</u> may enter Thailand without quarantine provided that they are <u>fully vaccinated at least 14 days before</u> <u>travelling</u> and have been in the eligible areas for at least 21 consecutive days.
- o They must have a <u>fully-paid SHA+ or AQ hotel reservation for at least 1 night, inclusive of one RT-PCR test.</u>
- They must also have health insurance in English which expressly covers treatments related to COVID-19 with minimum coverage of 50,000 USD and negative RT-PCR test result issued within 72 hours before departure.
- They will have to take an RT-PCR test on the day of arrival and will be allowed to leave the hotel after receiving their negative test result.
- Eligible travellers who have already paid for their 7 or 10 days at SHA+ or AQ hotel <u>may submit their request for refund directly to</u> their hotels.

• New Registration Platform

- On 1 November 2021, the Certificate of Entry (COE) platform will be discontinued. Those wishing to enter Thailand will have to register via the new platform, "Thailand Pass" (http://tp.consular.go.th). They must register through the new platform at least 7 days before departure.
- o Instead of COE, travellers will need to show a **QR Code generated through the Thailand Pass system** upon check-in and arrival in Thailand.
- o Those who have already been issued COEs before 1 November 2021 may use their COEs to enter Thailand. There is no need to register again for Thailand Pass.
