
# Common Mistakes in applying for Thai e-Visa

Please exercise caution in completing their applications to avoid any possible mistakes, which could lead to cancellation or rejection of the applications. Application processing fee (visa fee) will **NOT** be refunded in either case.



DON'T(s)	WHAT YOU SHOULD DO
<ul> <li>Don't fill in an online application form with a different name from that on the passport</li> <li>Example: if your first name is Robert, you have to fill in Robert, NOT Rob or Bob. Please stick to the details in your passport that is used to apply for an e-Visa.</li> <li>Don't fill in with initial(s).</li> <li>Don't use - or N/A or X or anything to indicate that you do not have that part of the name. Just leave that field blank.</li> <li>Example: if you do not have a middle name, just leave the middle name field blank. But if it is a REQUIRED field, please put "-" (dash).</li> <li>Don't miss out space when there is space.</li> <li>Example: if your family name is Stancheva Yordanova, you should fill in Stancheva Yordanova (with space between Stancheva and</li> </ul>	First name: Mihaela Middle Name: Stefania Family Name: Popescu Passport No.: 040017031



IMPORTANT	
<ul> <li>Simple mistake(s) could lead to rejection of your application. Fee will NOT be refunded in any case.</li> <li>The Embassy CANNOT edit your personal details for you.</li> <li>With a wrong full name, even if the Embassy had granted you a visa, you would likely encounter difficulty at immigration checkpoint when you enter Thailand.</li> </ul>

Number or Alphabet? - in your passport number  Don't mistake between  O [zero] and O ["O"scar]  B [eight] and B ["B"ravo]  S [five] and S ["S"iera]	<ul> <li>Please make sure you type in a correct passport number.</li> <li>0 [zero] is a bit flatter at the top and bottom while alphabet "0" [as in <i>O</i>scar] is more curvy.</li> </ul>

## DON'T(s)

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Simple mistake(s) could lead to rejection of your application.
   Fee will NOT be refunded in any case.
- The Embassy CANNOT edit your personal details for you.
- With a wrong passport number in your visa, you may encounter complication at immigration checkpoint upon your arrival in Thailand and whenever you need to present your visa.



## 3. Supporting documents

 Don't submit supporting documents for your own

- o Before starting the application process, **please refer to the information from:** 
  - o user's manual
  - o user's manual video clips
- o If you have more than one file for each supporting document section, i.e. more than one file of airplane tickets or accommodation bookings, **you must combine them**

### DON'T(s)

- satisfaction **BUT** as requested or indicated in the application.
- Don't submit financial evidence showing unreasonable balance for a person to stay abroad. The recommended minimum amount should be 20,000 THB per person and 40,000 THB per family for a single entry tourist visa. For other types of visa, please follow the requirements as instructed in the e-Visa system.
- Don't upload a document file that does not meet the required formats/size. The files should be in .JPG / .JPEG / .PDF formats with the maximum size of 3MB.

#### **IMPORTANT**

- Uploading only a one-way ticket or incomplete accommodation bookings for the entire period of your stay will be considered as not meeting the requirements.
- Documents which are not in English or Thai WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- into one single file and upload it to the system as per the required file formats and size.
- Proof of finance: if you are employed, please submit an employment certificate issued by your company. If you are a business owner, please submit a copy of your company registration. You must also present an up-to-date bank account statement together with your proof of employment as stated above and combine them into one .pdf file.
- Airplane tickets, accommodation bookings, bank account statements, etc. must have your name in English on them in order to prove that they are your documents.




# DON'T(s)

- 5. "Your picture holding the photo and information page of the passport"
  - Don't submit just a photo of your passport
  - Don't submit just a photo of only your hand(s) and your passport

### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- Submit NOT just a photo of your passport BUT literally a photo of you holding your own passport which is opened and show the data page (the page with your photo and personal information).

### 6. Email

- Don't mistype your own email.
- Don't use an email that is full or practically unreachable.

IMPORTANT	
<ul> <li>All automatic communications between the e-Visa system and you are done through the email you provided. This includes the delivery of your visa once approved.</li> </ul>	
7. "Photograph *taken within the last six months"	
<ul> <li>Don't use a cropped photo from your passport.</li> <li>Don't use other types of photo that do not match the requirements (e.g. photo with objects in the background, etc.)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Please submit a proper passport photo with a white background NOT a photo cropped from your passport or other types of photo that do not match the requirements.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>If the photograph does not reflect your current appearance, you may be refused to enter Thailand.</li> </ul>	

DON'T(s)	WHAT YOU SHOULD DO
<ul> <li>B. Nationality</li> <li>Don't be confused about your nationality especially when you hold more than one nationality.</li> <li>Notes:         <ul> <li>Your nationality at birth can differ from your nationality as appears on your passport.</li> </ul> </li> <li>IMPORTANT         <ul> <li>Mistake will lead to rejection of your application. Fee will NOT be refunded in any case.</li> <li>The Embassy CANNOT edit your personal details for you.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Please refer to the data in the passport you use to apply for an e-Visa.</li> <li>For example, if you use a Romanian passport to apply, you should put "Romanian" as your nationality.</li> </ul>
