Announcement
on additional supporting documents required for visa application

In reference to the Notification of the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand on Practical Guideline for Air Operators Performing Flights into the Kingdom of Thailand issued on 19 March 2020, **starting from 22 March 2020 until further notice**, all foreigners travelling to Thailand require to present the additional following documents to the air operators at check-in:

1. **Health certificate** certifying that the passengers "pose no risk of being infected by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)", issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel.

2. **Health insurance**/health insurance policy that shows minimum medical coverage of 100,000 USD in Thailand and covers the Covid-19 Disease.

If the passenger is unable to present the required above documents, the air operator will not issue a boarding pass and the boarding will be denied.

In this connection, **the visa applicants require to submit the aforementioned health certificate and health insurance** in addition to the ordinary required documents. If the visa applicant is unable to present the required above documents, the visa application will be denied.
