



# Entry Request to Thailand

## for non - Thai nationals holding a Work Permit

### Application

#### 1 Qualification



Only Non-Thai nationals with a **valid work permit** or **permission** from a **Thai government agency** to work in Thailand



Applications will be considered on a case by case basis, taking into account of **urgency** and **economic importance**



#### 2 Applying for Certificate of Entry



Contact the **Royal Thai Embassy** or **Royal Thai Consulate-General** in the country of departure to apply for a **“Certificate of Entry into the Kingdom of Thailand (COE)”** at least 10 working days before the date of intended departure



##### Requirement



**Completed Declaration Form** (Obtained from the Royal Thai Embassy or Consulate-General)



**Copy of his/her work permit** or copy of **letter of permission** to work issued by a Thai government agency to work in Thailand



**Valid health insurance** policy covering all expenditures of medical treatments, including **COVID-19** worth at least **100,000 USD**



#### Important Notes



The incoming **Flight ban** is still in place so **flight options** may be **limited**



On arrival in Thailand you'll be required to complete **quarantine** at your **own expense**

#### 3 When Entry Permission is Approved



**Booking a room for 14 days** at a government-designated **Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ)** facility at his/her **own expenses**

### Leaving for Thailand

#### 4 At the port of departure you must present

1 **Certificate of Entry (COE)**

2 **Declaration Form**

3 **Fit to Fly Health Certificate** issued by a doctor no more than 72 hours before departure

4 **Health insurance**



#### 5 Entry into Thailand



Subject to a **14-day state quarantine** at a government-designated **Alternative State Quarantine** facility
