	Please supply 3 copies of visa application form and 3 passport sized photos for a visa to travel to Thailand, together with 3 copies of proof of residence document in New Zealand (e.g. Permanent Resident Visa, etc.); ( <i>mandatory</i> )
	If either holding a resident, student or works permit in New Zealand, you must submit a valid <b>letter of recommendation</b> from your educational institute or employer with the application;
	OR
	If <u>NOT</u> holding a resident, student or work permit visa in New Zealand, your application will be processed through Ministry of Foreign Affair in Thailand and the <u>visa processing time could take up to 2 months</u> .
2. Fo	r minors <u>under 20 years old</u> , please provide <u>ALL</u> of the following additional documents;
	Notarized copy of marriage certificate. In case of sole custody notarized copy of court order must be provided;  Notarized copy of original passports or national ID Card of mother and father/ legal guardian;
	and Notarized or original <b>letter of consent for the minor to travel abroad</b> from mother and father/legal guardian(s).
