Announcement on list of non-Thai nationals permitted to enter Thailand

By virtue of the Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) and Section 11 of the State Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the entry to Thailand is permitted for particular persons in the exempted list. The list for non-Thai nationals includes the following:

- 1. Non-Thai nationals who are spouses, parents, or children of Thai nationals;
- 2. Non-Thai nationals who have a certificate of residence, or have been permitted to take up residency in Thailand;
- 3. Non-Thai nationals who have a work permit or have been granted permission to work in Thailand in accordance with Thai laws, including their spouses or children;
- 4. Non-Thai national who are students of educational establishments in Thailand approved by Thai authorities, including their parents or guardians, except for students of nonformal schools in accordance with laws on private schools or of any other similar private educational establishments:
- 5. Non-Thai nationals who need to receive medical treatment in Thailand, including their accompanying persons, except for treatment for COVID-19;
- 6. Non-Thai nationals who are permitted to enter Thailand under a special arrangement with a foreign country or have been granted permission by the Prime Minister;
 - 6.1 Approved Thailand Elite Member
 - 6.2 Long Stay Visitor (Non-Immigrant O-A and O-X visa holder)
- 6.3 Medium-Term Visitor (Tourist Visa Holder (single entry) and Business and Investor)
 - 6.4 Special Tourist Visa (STV) Holder
 - Approved Film Crew Member
