In this regard, the Royal Thai Consulate-General, Fukuoka hereby announces the revision of its consular services as follows

1. Services Hours

Royal Thai Consulate-General, Fukuoka, provides all consular services during Monday - Friday (except Public Holidays) 9.30 - 11.30 hrs. and 13.30 - 15.30 hrs. However, all applicants are advised to make an appointment in advance.

2. Consular Services

2.1 For Thai National

2.1.1 Royal Thai Consulate-General, Fukuoka, provides all consular services namely Thai passport enrolment, Civil and Family Registration, Thai I.D. Card, Legalizations, and other services.

2.1.2 Applicants are advised to prepare related documents prior to their appointments. Details and requirement for each consular service can be retrieved via website <u>https://fukuoka.thaiembassy.org</u>. Appointment with consular section can be made through following channels;

2.2 For Non-Thai National

2.2.1 Visa Application

For Non-Thai nationals residing in Kyushu, Okinawa and Chugoku regions, who wish to apply for the visa to enter Thailand, may check the processes of visa application and its requirement via our website <u>https://fukuoka.thaiembassy.org/en/index</u> (Tab: Consular Services). All applicants are advised to make an appointment for visa submission (Visa Appointment Booking Online – VABO) via the above-mentioned link. 2.2.2 Certificate of Entry - COE

For Non-Thai Nationals who wish to enter Thailand, it is necessary to have Certificate of Entry (COE) which can be retrieved via <u>https://coethailand.mfa.go.th/</u>. For inquiries, please contact the Consular Section by email visa.fuk@mfa.mail.go.th

3. Prevention Measures against COVID-19 at consular section

(1) All visitors are suggested to make an appointment in advance to avoid crowed situation.

(2) Non-related parties are not allowed to enter consular section.

(3) Please clean your hands by soap or provided alcohol-based hand rub.

(4) Please wear face mask at all time during using our services. In case you have symptoms such as cough or fever, please avoid making the appointment.

(5) Body temperature of all applicants and visitors will be checked. For those who have body temperature more than 37.5°C, will not be permitted for all services without prejudice.

These measures are effective from 1 October 2021 until future notice.
