2.1	Receipt of currency exchange of USD 700/ 20,000 Thai Baht per person OR USD 1400/ 40,000 Thai Baht per family		
2.2	A photocopy of the valid international credit card with applicant's name visible.		
2.3	Bank statement of six months with current balance of USD 700 per person.

3.1	Proof Of Hotel / accommodation reservation in Thailand with contact number and address		
4	ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS		
4.1	Film: Original letter of permission-to-film from Thai Film Office and Office of Tourism Development.		
4.2	Film: Crew List attached with every application.		
4.3	Press: Permission from Press Division, Department of Information, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand.(In Case of Media/Journalist coverage)
