




TAT Mumbai Director's Message

List of Outdoor and Adventure Activities in Amazing Thailand Sky Diving



Most people wouldn't think of Thailand as a popular place to try skydiving. However, there are a number of reasons why skydiving has become a popular activity in Thailand. First and foremost the weather makes it ideal to skydive Thailand nearly year round. While the monsoon season does bring inclement weather, Thailand's weather is very predictable and it's easy to schedule a clear jump day. Furthermore, Thailand skydiving prices are very reasonable, allowing visitors to do a tandem jump as a half day activity or make a whole holiday out of it by getting certified in as few as three days. The most popular destination to skydive Thailand is Pattaya

White Water Rafting

With the monsoon season rains Thailand's rivers swell and visitors have the opportunity to take part in one of Thailand's most exciting outdoor adventures: white water rafting. Rafting day trips may also include visits to hill tribe villages and even mountain biking or elephant riding.
