### Obama Pays First Visit To Thailand

President Barrack Obama launched a three-day Southeast Asia tour, hailing alliances with countries such as Thailand as cornerstones of the administration's deeper commitment to the Asia-Pacific region. Mr. Obama landed in Bangkok on 16th November, greeted by 40 saluting military guards who flanked both sides of a red carpet.

The visit to Thailand, less than 18 hours long, is a gesture of friendship to a long-standing partner and major non-NATO ally.



### Thai Tourism Will Surpass 21m

TMB Bank's think-tank unit, TMB Analytics, estimates international tourist arrivals to Thailand will reach 21 million by year-end, which would generate Bt920 billion in tourism revenue.

The government expects tourism to earn Bt2 trillion within three years from both domestic and international visits.

The survey ranked 25 cities in the Asia - Pacific region for their overall shopping experience, based on categories like Shops, Affordability, Convenience, Hotels & Transport, and Culture & Climate. Bangkok's impressive showing was due to its consistently high scoring across all categories, particularly in Affordability with a near-perfect 99-out-of-100 score in the two- and four-star hotel average-cost subcategory, and an 87/100 in city transport, which rated the average cost of bus and taxi fares in the city center.

## Bangkok Airways & Japan Airlines Start Codeshare & Mileage Tie-up

Bangkok Airways (PG) and Japan Airlines (JAL) announced the commencement of their codeshare agreement on selected flights between three airports in Japan and Bangkok operated by JAL, as well as between Bangkok and four points within the region on PG, effective from November 15, 2012.

The new partnership will enable customers of both Japan Airlines and Bangkok Airways travelling from Tokyo's Haneda and Narita airports, and Osaka (Kansai), a smoother transit through Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi Airport and onward to Mumbai, Koh Samui, Phuket and Chiang Mai, and vice versa.
