

Announcement of the Royal Thai Consulate-General, Mumbai Subject: Auction of Used Vehicle

The Royal Thai Consulate-General in Mumbai wishes to sell its used van by sealed envelope tender. Details as follows:

1. Vehicle (Van) Details: Toyota Hiace Commuter GL, 3000 CC, Diesel, 15-seater, Silver, Manufactured and purchased in 2012 (imported) - photos as shown in Annex

2. Mileage: 174,564 kilometres

3. Minimum Bid: INR 650,000.-

4. **Bidding Date:** 8-22 May 2025, Monday to Friday, 0930h to 1630h, except on official holidays (5 and 12 May 2025). The winner of the bid will be announced on 23 May 2025.

5. Condition of the Vehicle: Well-maintained with regular servicing

6. **Venue:** All bids must be submitted in-person in a sealed envelope (labelled "Tender Document for Auction of Used Vehicle") at the Royal Thai Consulate-General in Mumbai (12th Floor, Express Towers, Barrister Rajni Patel Marg, Nariman Point, Mumbai).

7. The vehicle is sold on an as-is, where-is basis. Bidders must thoroughly read this announcement and review the vehicle information before submitting the bid. Bidders are deemed to have read and agreed to the terms and conditions of the auction as laid out in this announcement, and must not request the Consulate-General to make any changes, adjustments, or repairs to the vehicle.

8. Bidders must offer a bidding price not less than the above-mentioned minimum bid. The vehicle will be sold to the highest bidder. The winner of the bid will obtain the right to purchase the vehicle and must make the payment in full or a deposit of fifty (50) percent of the bidding price (by demand draft) to the Royal Consulate-General in Mumbai, along with personal identification documents. Once the payment has been confirmed, a receipt will be issued to the winner as proof of payment. The remaining balance, if any, must be paid in full (by demand draft) within three (3) working days after the date of the deposit. The vehicle must be collected within three (3) working days after the full payment has been made.

9. Any fees associated with the transfer of ownership of the vehicle, changing license plate, transportation costs, taxes and other relevant expenses shall be paid by the winner of the bid.

10. Should the winner of the bid fail to complete the payment in full within the designated date, the winner of the bid is deemed to have waived the right to purchase the vehicle and will not be able to recover any relevant costs.

11. The bidder must not conspire with other bidder(s) and/or obstruct the bidding
