


VISA ON ARRIVAL (VOA)

Nationals of the following <u>31 countries and territories</u> may apply for visa on arrival <u>at the immigration checkpoints</u> on arrival for tourism purpose

VISA EXEMPTION (60 DAYS)

Nationals of the **following 93 countries and territories** are entitled to visa exemption for the purpose of tourism business engagements or urgent work or ad-hoc work, **for a up to 60 days period of stay and can be extended for another period not exceeding 30 days**. Extension of stay is solely at the discretion of the immigration officer. Before the maximum stay of 90 days **are eligible to apply for a new type of visa in Thailand**.

The following countries have bilateral agreements for visa exemption with Thailand** Argentina, Chile, Myanmar (International airports only)

For Necessary or Urgent Work or Ad-hoc Work need to notify the registrar in person at any international airport or labour offices in Thailand. The process takes one working day and can only be obtained after the foreigner has entered Thailand. The work shall be completed within 15 days.

16 Types of Necessary or Urgent Work or Ad-hoc Work :

- Organizing or setting up conferences, trainings, seminars, exhibitions, or trade fairs
- Conducting special academic lectures
- Aviation superintendent

- Machinery maintenance and installation
- Electric train technician
- Aircraft or aircraft equipment system technician
 Consulting work on machinery maintenance or machinery control system

- Occasional internet audit
- Follow-up and resolve technical issues
- Quality control of products/goods or products/goods quality inspection
- Inspection or improvement of production process
- Machinery and electric generator equipment system inspection or maintenance

**The period of stay is based on respective bilateral agreements



NON-ED PLUS VISA

Non-ED Plus Visa aims to facilitate international students studying at universities in Thailand at the bachelor's degree level or above.



Benefits

Exempted from Re-Entry Permit

During the course of study, foreign students in bachelor degree level or higher can depart and re-enter Thailand without the need for a re-entry permit.

Extensions of Stays

Universities/Institutions will submit the visa extension application on behalf of the students.

Extended Stay for Graduated Student

Foreign students are allowed to extend the stay in Thailand for 1 year after graduating, to seek employment, travel or participate in other activities and are eligible to apply for new type of visa in Thailand if employed.



Where to apply:



Eligible Foreigners:

- 1. Digital Nomads/Remote Workers/Freelancers 2. Participants in activities such as
 - Muay Thai courses
 - Thai Cooking classes
 - Sport training
 - Medical treatment
 - Seminars
 - Music Festivals
- 3. Spouse and dependent children of DTV holders







Required Documents:

- 1. Passport or Travel Document
- 2. Photograph
- **3. Document Indicating Current Location**
- 4. Financial evidence: amount of no less than 500,000 THB, e.g. bank statements, payslips, sponsorship letter
- 5. Purpose of Visit
 - a. Workcation: Employment contract or employment certificate in their country or professional portfolio showcasing digital nomad, remote worker, foreign talent or freelancer status b. Thai soft power: Proof of confirmation to

appointment from hospital/medical center

c. Spouse: Proof of relationship to the DTV

visa holder, e.g. a copy of marriage

certificate / birth certificate /

attend the activity or letter of

certificate of adoption
