

申请教师签证的规定

（以赴泰国教育机构工作为目的的签证）

停留期限：不超过 90 天

签证费用：人民币 480 元

申请材料：1. 有效期超过 6 个月的护照；

2. 有效的身份证件；

3. 护照规格的近期电子彩照；

4. 泰方院校签发的正式**邀请函**（签证处不接受传真件或 EMAIL 信函），该邀请函用英文或泰文书写，注明被邀请人的职位、期限和工资等，盖公章并由负责人签字，并注明院校地址以及联系电话；

5. 泰国校方盖章认可的泰国**学校经营许可证和注册登记材料**；

6. **毕业证或学历证明**；

7. 对前往泰国**私立学校和私立教育机构**任教的人员，需要另外补充如下材料：

7.1 由泰国政府教育部门签发的批文，批准该人前往该学校任教（签证处不接受传真件或 EMAIL 信函）；

7.2 经过泰国校方盖章认可的泰国学校经营许可证和注册登记材料的复印件；

8. 经过省外事办公室和泰王国驻昆明领事馆认证的《无犯罪记录公证书》

备注：

1. 申请者必须通过电子签证申请网站 www.thaievisa.go.th 进行申请，并按照要求通过系统提交相关文件。签证获批后，申请者将会收到电子邮件和系统通知，您的签证将以“无贴纸”形式签发，系统会向申请者的电子邮箱发送签证通知函，可从系统下载。建议签证申请者在出行前打印签证通知函以便移民检查站审查。

2. 泰王国驻昆明总领事馆只受理以下签证申请者所提交的申请：

- 护照“签发地点”为云南省、贵州省和湖南省的中国公民；

- 持有由云南省、贵州省和湖南省签发的中华人民共和国港澳台居民居住证的香港、澳门或台湾居民；

- 持有由云南省、贵州省和湖南省签发的中华人民共和国居留许可的外国人。

3. 申请者必须通过系统提交清楚、清晰、高质的真实文件扫描件。泰领馆根据情况会要求补充文件和/或面签（通过电子方式或亲自面签）。如果提交的材料被发现是伪造的文件，或未经授权进行涂改的文件，签证申请将被拒绝。

签证延期及停留：

若需要在泰王国停留更长时间，可以到泰王国国家移民局办理签证延期。详情可访问网址：<http://www.immigration.go.th>，签证延期及停留的最终解释权为泰王国移民局。

VISA for Teaching in Thailand (NON-B VISA)

FOR: those who wish to work in an educational institution in Thailand

PERMIT TO STAY: not exceeding 90 days

FEE: 480 RMB

- DOCUMENTS:**
1. Passport with a validity of not less than 6 months.
 2. ID card.
 3. A recent passport-sized electronic photo.
 4. Letter of Invitation in English or Thai from the Education Institution in Thailand, stating that the applicant is invited or employed. Details on the letter should include position, salary and duration of contract, with official seal, signature of the legally authorised representative, address and contact number of the education institution in Thailand (fax or email is not acceptable).
 5. For GOVERNMENT/PUBLIC Institutions, documentation proving establishment of the institution (such as the legislation or order establishing the institution, or a certifying letter), for PRIVATE institutions, the Permit/License of the institution issued by the relevant authority.
 6. The academic certificate or graduation certificate of the applicant plus one copy.
 7. FOR THOSE GOING TO TEACH AT PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THAILAND, additional documents are required as follows:
 - 7.1 The original admission letter issued by the relevant authority under the Ministry of Education of Thailand (fax or email is not acceptable).
 - 7.2 The certified true copy of business license of the institution.
 8. The Notarial Certificate of No Record of Criminal Offence certified by FAO and RTCG in Kunming.

NOTE

1. Applications must be submitted using the "E-Visa" system, through the website www.thaievisa.go.th. All applicants will be requested to submit relevant documents through the system. Once the visa is approved, applicants will be notified by email and on the system, and your visa will be issued in "stickerless" format. A notification letter will be sent by the system to your email, and downloadable from the system. Before traveling, the visa applicant is advised to print the said letter to present at immigration checkpoints, if requested.
2. The RTCG Kunming will only process visa applications submitted by:
 - Chinese nationals who are resident in Yunnan, Guizhou, or Hunan Province, as shown by the "PLACE OF ISSUE" on your passport;
 - Hong Kong, Macau, or Taiwan residents whose resident permits in the People's Republic of China were issued in Yunnan, Guizhou, or Hunan Province; and
 - Non-Chinese foreign nationals whose resident permits for the People's Republic of China were issued in Yunnan, Guizhou, or Hunan Province.
3. Applicants must submit clear, legible, and good-quality scans of their authentic documents through the system. The RTCG may request further documents and/or interviews (electronically or in person), as necessary. IF DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED ARE FOUND TO BE FAKE, OR ADJUSTED WITHOUT AUTHORISATION, YOUR VISA APPLICATION WILL BE REFUSED.

EXTENSION OF STAY

Those who wish to stay longer must apply to the relevant offices of the Thai Immigration Bureau, or at a provincial Immigration Office (see: <http://www.immigration.go.th>) in Thailand. Extensions of stay and changes of visa type are solely at the discretion of the Immigration Bureau.
