



Announcement No.21 on the Entry Procedures for Non-Thai Nationals who are Eligible to Enter the Kingdom of Thailand

With reference to the Royal Thai Embassy's Announcement No. 20 on the Entry Procedures for Non-Thai Nationals who are Eligible to Enter the Kingdom of Thailand dated 30 June 2022, the Royal Thai Embassy wishes to inform all non-Thai nationals who wish to enter into the Kingdom of Thailand of the latest entry procedures as follows:

Step 1: Please check whether a traveller already has a valid visa to enter Thailand.

1.1 If the traveller does not have a valid visa, please proceed to step 2 - 3.

1.2 The traveller who has a valid visa or does not need one (*see box below*), is eligible to enter into Thailand without having to apply for a new visa.

Important Note

All travellers who are scheduled to arrive in the Kingdom of Thailand from 1 October 2022 onwards are no longer required to present COVID-19 related documents such as the certificate of vaccination and COVID-19 test result upon arrival in Thailand.

Step 2: The traveller is required to apply for a visa online via the link <https://www.thaievisa.go.th/> through the following steps:

- 2.1 Create an account.
- 2.2 Check eligibility and purpose of visit.
- 2.3 Fill in the online application form.
- 2.4 Add travel information.
- 2.5 Upload required documents.
- 2.6 Review application.
- 2.7 Pay for visa fee (*if applicable*).

Step 3: After the e-visa application has been approved, a confirmation e-mail will be automatically sent to the traveller.

The traveller is requested to print a copy of the e-visa confirmation e-mail to present to airline and Thai immigration officials when travelling to Thailand.

Important Notes

- A visa applicant is no longer required to submit his/her passport nor any of the required original documents in person at the Royal Thai Embassy in Seoul.
- The processing time for e-visa approval takes at least 5 working days (*excluding the submission day*).
- Incomplete or inaccurate e-visa applications may result in visa processing delay or visa refusal.
- A visa applicant is advised to plan the trip carefully to minimize the possibility of not getting the visa approved in time.
- Due to the Agreement on Visa Fee Exemption between Thailand and the Republic of Korea, signed in 1967, Korean passport holders are entitled for visa fee exemption.

Remarks

- * Passport holders of Brazil, Korea (ROK) and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil, Korea (ROK) and Peru.
- ** Passport holders of Vietnam and Hong Kong are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 30 days with Vietnam and Hong Kong.
- *** From 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023, the period of stay for visa-on-arrival is extended from 15 to 30 days.
- **** From 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023, the period of stay for tourist visa exemption scheme is extended from 30 to 45 days. In addition, the period of stay for bilateral agreements on visa exemption are extended from 14 and 30 days to 45 days.
