- Award winners are asked to submit their original artworks within 7 days of

the announcement of the winners.

(2) Illustrations

- A2 format (420 × 594mm or 23.4 x 16.5 inches)
- Resolution, format, and size: 150dpi or higher; JPG, JPEG, PNG;

Maximum size: 10MB

- Please scan hand-drawn artworks and submit them as digital files.

- Award winners are required to submit their original artworks at a later date (high-definition files such as AI, PSD, and EPS over 300dpi).

- Award winners are asked to submit their original artworks within 7 days of the announcement of the winners.

(3) Webtoons

- Complete works with 4 to 8 frames (width 1,280 pixel, length optional)

- Resolution, format and size: 150dpi or higher; JPG, JPEG, or PNG; Maximum size: 10MB

- Please scan hand-drawn artworks and submit them as digital files.

- Award winners are required to submit their original artworks at a later date (high-definition files such as AI, PSD, and EPS over 300dpi).

- Award winners are asked to submit their original artworks within 7 days of the announcement of the winners.

- Submitted artworks and any related documents will not be returned.

- Participants in this contest grant the ASEAN Culture House the right to use and display their submitted artworks publicly, both online and offline, as part of an exhibition of the winning entries, in promotional materials related to this year's and future contests, and on the website and social media accounts of the ASEAN Culture House and the Korea Foundation. In addition to their prize money, participants whose winning entries will be used for the aforesaid purposes will receive no other payments.

- Submissions that were not selected as winning entries will be discarded within 3 months from the date of the contest.

- The jury reserves the right to select fewer winners than the total number of prizes. Personal information about jury members as well as details of the evaluation process will not be disclosed to participants or other outsiders.
