

Persons on Diplomatic or Consular Missions or under International Organizations, or Representatives of Foreign Governments or Agencies Performing Their Duties in Thailand, or any other Persons in International Agencies, that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Gives Permission Pertaining to Necessity, including their Spouses, Parents or Children

1. Valid passport no less than 6 months;
2. Photo in color taken within the last 6 months to reflect your current appearance, taken in front of white background, full-face view directly facing the camera (photo must not be the same as the photo in the current passport);
3. Document indicating the applicant's current residency:
For Korean nationals: Resident Register,
For non-Korean nationals: a copy of Alien Registration Card front-back;
3.1 Certificate of Entry and Departure (1-year record);
4. Note verbale from the country's government of the applicant stating the following details:
 - (a) In case of Official or Diplomatic visit:
 - Name of the applicant
 - Type of passport and passport number
 - Position of the applicant
 - Purpose of visit
 - Duration of visit
 - (b) In case of posting in Thailand:
 - Name of the applicant
 - Type of passport and passport number
 - Position of the applicant
 - Type of posting: Assumption of duty or Resumption of duty.
 - I. In case of assumption of duty, please specify the name and position of predecessor.
 - Term of service
