The Royal Thai Embassy has the honour to announce the change of the regulation regarding visa applications to Thailand which will be effective from 1 January 2015 as follows;

#### 1. Tourist Visa

- 1.1 <u>Israeli Passport/Travel Document Holders</u>
  - 1) Documents required;
    - Passport or travel document with validity NOT less than 6 months
    - Visa application form **COMPLETELY** filled out
- Two recent (4 x 6 cm.) colour photographs of the applicant, taken within the past 6 months
  - Air ticket and hotel reservation documents may also be requested
  - Parents permission form is required for children aged under 16
  - 2) Visa fee;
- 150.- NIS per entry. The maximum number of entries allowed will be 3 entries.
  - 3) Duration of the process;
- ONE full working day except Thursday, Friday and other Embassy holidays.
- 1.2 <u>Non-Israeli Passport Holders</u> (Reserved only for residents of Israel or holders of valid working/student/spouse visas.)
  - 1) Documents required;
    - Passport or travel document with validity NOT less than 6 months
    - Visa application form <u>COMPLETELY</u> filled out
- Two recent (4 x 6 cm.) colour photographs of the applicant, taken within the past 6 months
- Air ticket and Hotel reservation document <u>covering the</u> whole <u>period</u> of stay in Thailand
- Jordanian passport holders must provide a copy of the ID cards indicating the residence in Israel
- Palestinian, Indian, Nepali, Sri Lankan passport holders, please see attachment

#### 2) Visa fee;

150.- NIS per entry. The maximum number of entries allowed will be 3 entries.

3) Duration of the process;

THREE working days except Thursday, Friday and other Embassy holidays.

### 2. Non-Immigrant Visa

1) Documents required;

The required documents are varied, based on the type of the visas. Please contact the visa section, Royal Thai Embassy, Tel Aviv for information (Tel. +972 9 954 8412 – 13 or at <a href="http://www.thaiembassy.org/telaviv/en">http://www.thaiembassy.org/telaviv/en</a>).

2) Visa fee;

300.- NIS per entry.

3) Duration of the process;

THREE working days except Thursday, Friday and other Embassy's holidays.

## 3. Other types of Visas

The Embassy will consider issuing the said visas upon request case by case.

Please be noted that the Embassy will accept all types of visa applications during 9.00 - 11.30 hours, Monday – Friday and the collection time will be during 14.00 - 16.00 hours, Monday - Thursday only.

# To Whom It May Concern,

- . In order to apply for a visa at the Embassy, the following revision of Visa applicant's information and supportive documents <u>MUST</u> be provided, otherwise the visa application will not be accepted:-
- 1. The applicant's full name exactly as it appears in the passport with the family name highlighted with a coloured marker pen;
  - 2. Full home address and private telephone number of the applicant;
- 3. 3 copies of the **confirmed** return air ticket certified by the travel agency (with the date of arrival and departure, flight number and airline name written on the visa application form and highlighted with a coloured marker pen);
- 4. 3 copies of the **confirmed** hotel reservation certified by the travel agency (the name and address of the hotel should be written on the visa application form at 'Proposed Address in Thailand' and highlighted with a coloured marker pen);
- 5. 3 clear photocopies of the passport and the passport that must be valid for more than 6 months from the date of arrival in Thailand;
  - 6. 4 recent identical colour passport size photos;
- 7. 4 correctly completed and signed visa application forms with 2 original signatures of applicant on each visa application form;
- 8. In the case of a group travel (more than 2 visa applicants), the travel agency should provide a letter with a full list of all applicants and provide all other necessary information;
- 9. If a traveler is less than 16 years of age, the parents must complete a child travel permission form.

The Consular Section will accept visa applications **ONLY** between 09.00 hrs. to 11.30 hrs. Monday to Friday, except for Thai and Israeli National holidays. The collection time is between 14.00 hrs. - 16.00 hrs.
