



ANNOUNCEMENT
A procedure of applying a Certificate of Entry (COE)
for non-Thai nationals who intend to enter Thailand

By virtue of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) and Section 11 of the State Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the entry into Thailand is permitted for non-Thai nationals only in respect of the following particular persons in the exemptions list;

- (1) Exempted persons or persons who are specified, permitted or invited by the Prime Minister or Chief official responsible for remedying the emergency situation to enter into the Kingdom pertaining to necessity, whereby conditions and time frames may also be prescribed;
- (2) Persons on diplomatic or consular missions or under international organizations, or representatives of foreign governments or agencies performing their duties in Thailand, or any other persons in international agencies, that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand gives permission pertaining to necessity, including their spouse, parents, or children;
- (3) Non-Thai nationals who are spouses, parents, or children of Thai nationals;
- (4) Non-Thai nationals who have a certificate of residence, or have been permitted to take up residency in the Kingdom;
- (5) Non-Thai nationals who have a work permit or have been granted permission to work in the Kingdom in accordance with Thai laws, including their spouses or children;
- (6) Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational establishments in Thailand approved by Thai authorities, including their parents or guardians, except for students of non-formal schools in accordance with laws on private schools or of any other similar private educational establishments;
- (7) Non-Thai nationals who need to receive medical treatment in Thailand, including their accompanying persons, except for treatment for COVID-19;

Currently, applicants for the following visa categories are not allowed to enter Thailand and will not be issued COE: Tourists (TR), Transit (TS), Sports (S), Religious (R), Retirement (O-A/O-X), Thailand Privilege (Elite card), Volunteers (O), and non-student such as those learning language or boxing classes.

***Please note that the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand (CAAT) has announced the extension of travel ban of commercial flights to Thailand until further notice.**

For Diplomats and Officials of International Organization and Family Members

1. Required Documents:

1.1. A Declaration Form with duly completed and signed with a copy of passport (Attachment 1)

1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);

1.1. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)

1.3. An official note issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs Pakistan or Afghanistan or International Organization requesting the Certificate of Entry, providing following information;

- Name, Date of Birth, Position and Duty, Date of traveling, as well as family members (if any) with a copy of passport

- Certifying that the applicant and family members consent to 14-day Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ).

1.4. A letter from the International Organization in Thailand affirming responsibility for healthcare or treatment expenses, or evidence showing a guarantee that applicant is able to take responsibility for his or her own healthcare or treatment expense, including for COVID-19 during the stay in Thailand, or a copy of insurance policy which covers COVID-19 with the minimum coverage of no less than 100,000 USD.

1.5. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)

1.6. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

For Work Permit Holders and Family Members

1. Required Documents:

1.1. A Declaration Form with duly completed and signed with a copy of passport (Attachment 2)

1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);

1.3. A copy of health insurance policy with coverage including COVID-related treatment in Thailand in the amount no less than 100,000 USD *

1.4. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)

1.5. A copy of work permit (if it is already expired, the employer should contact the Ministry of Labour to issue a WP3), or a copy of letter of permission to work in Thailand from a Thai government agency, such as the Ministry of Labour, the Ministry of Education, the Board of Investment (BOI).

1.6. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)

1.7. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

1.8. A copy of documents as proof of relationship, such as marriage certificate, or birth certificate, and copy of passport of applicant's accompanying family members (if any);

For Spouse and Family Members of Thai Nationals

1. Required Documents;

- 1.1. A Declaration Form with duly completed and signed with a copy of passport (Attachment 2)
- 1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);
- 1.3. A copy of health insurance policy with coverage including COVID-related treatment in Thailand in the amount no less than 100,000 USD *
- 1.4. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)
- 1.5. A copy of documents as proof of relationship, such as marriage certificate, or birth certificate, and copy of passport of such Thai national;
- 1.6. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)
- 1.7. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

For Medical Treatment in Thailand (Excluding COVID-19 treatment)

1. Required Documents;

- 1.1. A Declaration Form with duly completed and signed with a copy of Passport (Attachment 2)
- 1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);
- 1.3. Letter from the hospital in Thailand that they would admit the applicant to be an in-patient, and the arrangement for transfer from the airport to the hospital and 14-day quarantine at the hospital
- 1.4. Financial evidence that the applicant has sufficient fund to pay for your medical treatment in Thailand, such as bank statement
- 1.5. A copy of health insurance policy with coverage including COVID-related treatment in Thailand in the amount no less than 100,000 USD *
- 1.6. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)
- 1.7. A copy of documents as proof of relationship, such as marriage certificate, or birth certificate, and copy of passport of applicant’s accompanying person or family members
- 1.8. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)
- 1.9. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

For Students Attending Schools or Universities in Thailand

- 1.1. A Declaration Form with duly completed and signed with a copy of passport (Attachment 2)
 - 1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);
 - 1.3. Letter confirming enrollment details from school or university signed by authorized person together with a copy of ID card or passport of the signer
 - 1.4. A copy of health insurance policy with coverage including COVID-related treatment in Thailand in the amount no less than 100,000 USD *
 - 1.5. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)
 - 1.6. A copy of documents as proof of relationship, such as marriage certificate, or birth certificate, and copy of passport of the applicant's accompanying family members (if any)
 - 1.7. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)
 - 1.8. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

 - 1.2. A confirmed flight ticket from Pakistan or Afghanistan to Thailand (a booking ticket without confirmation will not be accepted);
 - 1.3. A Copy of Certificate of Residence;
 - 1.4. A copy of health insurance policy with coverage including COVID-related treatment in Thailand in the amount no less than 100,000 USD *
 - 1.5. A copy of a reservation for Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) at one of the hotels approved by the Thai Government (Attachment 3)
 - 1.6. A COVID-19 free Health Certificate issued no longer than 72 hours before departure. (COVID-19 must be tested by RT-PCR method)
 - 1.7. A Fit to Fly / Fit to Travel issued no longer than 72 hours before departure.

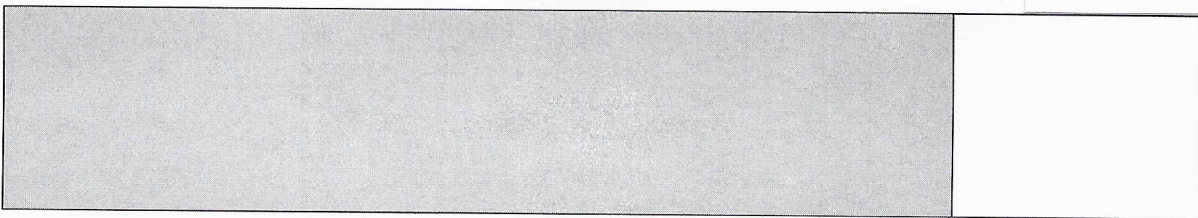
