Destination Thailand Visa


With reference to the Royal Thai Embassy's Announcement No. 10 / 2565 dated 23 August B.E. 2565 (2022) on the Addition of the Long-Term Resident Visa (LTR), the Royal Thai Government has introduced "the Destination Thailand Visa (DTV)" for long-term tourism and workcation, which allows multiple entries with 5-year validity from 15 July 2024.
