

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations (DCIOs) in Thailand and, further to the Ministry's Note No. 0404/c.598 dated 2 April B.E. 2564 (2021) regarding the Order of the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) No. 4/2564 dated 31 March B.E. 2564 (2021) and in view of the current COVID-19 outbreak in several provinces, has the honour to seek cooperation from the DCIOs in the effort to contain the spread of the COVID-19 as recommended by the Department of Disease Control as follows:

- 1. Convey and encourage the following recommendations to its citizens and staff members residing in Thailand:
- 1.1 Avoid travelling across provinces and refrain from joining mass gathering activities. If inter-provincial travel is necessary, please attentively study the updated COVID-19 situation and preventive measures of the areas.
- 1.2 Monitor their health condition for abnormal symptoms. As a number of recent infections were found from entertainment venues in Bangkok and its vicinity, those who have visited such venues are recommended to disclose their full risk history to medical officers at the hospital and strictly abide by the COVID-19 prevention and control measures.
- 2. Promote compliance with the disease prevention and control measures announced by Thailand's Centre for the COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA). More information can be found on https://ddc.moph.go.th/viralpneumonia/eng/index.php.
- 3. The DCIOs are kindly requested to inform the Ministry without delay if any of their staff and family members is tested positive for the COVID-19.
