The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations (DCIOs) in Thailand and has the honour to inform the latter that the Prime Minister, in his capacity as Director of the Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA), has issued the Order of the Centre No. 4/2564, dated 31 March B.E. 2564 (2021), effective from 1 April B.E. 2564 (2021) onwards.

In this connection, the Ministry has further the honour to inform the latter that, taking into consideration the current COVID-19 situation, relevant regulations concerning entry into Thailand and the quarantine period have been updated. A brief summary is as follows:

1. The quarantine period for all travelers is adjusted to a range of 7-14 days, as below:

1.1 Seven Days Quarantine: Travelers who have completed a full course of vaccination (according to the vaccine manufacturer) at least 14 days prior to their departure with one of the COVID-19 vaccines registered in Thailand or approved by the World Health Organisation (WHO) or as determined by the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand, must be quarantined for no less than 7 days. Upon their arrival in Thailand, travelers are requested to present a vaccine certificate to the Health Control officers at the port of arrival.

1.2 Ten Days Quarantine: Travelers who are not vaccinated or have not completed the full course of vaccination must be quarantined for no less than 10 days.

1.3 Fourteen Days Quarantine: Travelers whose port of departure are located in areas where mutations and variants of the SAR-CoV-2 virus are found, as determined by the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand, must be quarantined for no less than 14 days.

2. For entry into Thailand, the Fit to Fly/Fit to Travel health certificate is no longer required. However, all other relevant documents are still required, including, but not limited to, a Certificate of Entry (COE), and a medical certificate with RT-PCR laboratory result with the validity of 72 hours prior to departure indicating that COVID-19 is not detected (COVID-Free).
