The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations (DCIOs) in Thailand and, further to the Ministry's Note No. 0905/434 dated 12 March B.E. 2563 (2020) circulating documents issued by the Ministry of Public Health related to measures against the spread of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), has the honour to inform the DCIOs as follows:

1. In line with the Royal Thai Government's instructions and stringent guidelines to control the COVID-19 situation in Thailand, the Ministry kindly seeks the cooperation of all DCIOs in Thailand to **refrain from organising and attending large-scale activities** including mass gatherings or large community events to mitigate the risk of transmitting COVID-19 until further notice.
