## **Foreigner**

To Check-in, require the presentation of







- 1 Health certificate certifying that the passengers "have no evidence of being infected by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)" with the laboratory test result, issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel (can be in English or in the official language of the country of departure).
- Health insurance/health insurance policy that shows minimum medical coverage of 100,000 USD in Thailand and covers the Covid-19 Disease.

## Thai

To Check-in, require the presentation of







- 1. Health certificate confirming that the passenger is fit to fly (can be in English or in the official language of the country of departure).
- 2 Letter issued by Royal Thai Embassy, Royal Thai Consulate-General or Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Kingdom of Thailand certifying that the passenger is Thai National returning to Thailand.

- \* The above documents can be in electronic form but they must be able to be presented to and verified by the airline staff when Check-in at the airport of departure and airport of destination.
- To enter Thailand, present to the communicable disease control official:







- 1. Completed T.8 Form or Provide information in "AOT Airport of Thailand" Application.
- 2. Subject to isolation, quarantine, under observation, or any other measures for the prevention and control of communicable diseases.
