The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations (DCIOs) in Thailand and, with reference to the Ministry's Note No. 0404/c.1137 dated 9 June B.E. 2563 (2020) forwarding information related to Regulation (No.9) issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), has the honour to inform the latter as follows:

- 1. On 12 June B.E. 2563 (2020), the Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) has approved the lifting of a nationwide curfew from 14 June B.E. 2563 (2020) at 2300 hrs. onwards and the fourth phase of easing COVID-19 restrictions, taking effect as of 15 June B.E. 2563 (2020) to enable businesses to recuperate and mitigate the economic and social impact of the pandemic. Nevertheless, international travels to Thailand by air, land, and sea will remain restricted, given that most of recent new infectious cases mostly involve individuals returning from abroad. Detailed information and guidelines for the fourth phase will be forwarded to the DCIOs in due course.
- 2. The Ministry wishes to suggest that the DCIOs become accustomed to social distancing, wearing face mask in public, and washing hands frequently as part of a new normal way of life to keep the DCIOs and the general public safe from COVID-19.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all Diplomatic Missions, Consular Representatives and International Organisations in Thailand the assurances of its highest consideration.
