Common Mistakes in Applying for Thai e-Visas

Please exercise caution in completing the applications to avoid any possible mistakes, which could lead to cancellation or rejection of the applications. Application processing fee (visa fee) will **NOT** be refunded in either case.

DON'T(s)

1. Full Name

- DO NOT misspell your own name
- DO NOT left out some parts of the full name
 - Example: if your full name is John Steve Doe, please fill in the entire name:

First name: JohnMiddle Name: SteveFamily Name: Doe

- DO NOT fill in an online application form with a different name from that on the passport
 - Example: if your first name is Robert, you have to fill in Robert, NOT Rob or Bob. Please stick to the details in your passport that is used to apply for an e-Visa.
 - If you have multiple middle names on other identification documents, please enter only the middle name(s) exactly as shown on your passport.
- DO NOT fill in with **initial(s)**.
- DO NOT use or N/A or X or anything to indicate that you do not have that part of the name. Just leave that field blank.
 - Example: if you do not have middle name, just leave the middle name field blank.
- DO NOT miss out space when there is space.
 Example: if your family name is Mac Donald, you should fill in Mac Donald (with space between Mac and Donald) NOT MacDonald.

IMPORTANT

- Simple mistake(s) could lead to rejection of your application. Fee will NOT be refunded in any case.
- The Consulate CANNOT edit your personal details for you.
- With a wrong full name, even if the Consulate had granted you a visa, you would likely encounter difficulty at immigration checkpoint when you enter Thailand.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

- Fill in your full name as appears in your passport and check if it is correctly spelled.

User's manual User's manual video clips **IMPORTANT Starting your application** Failure to submit all required documents could result in further delay or rejection of your application. Please check and make sure that you provide 4. Email the correct email. MAKE SURE your email is correct. DO NOT use an email that is full or unreachable. **IMPORTANT** All automatic communications between the e-Visa system and you are done through the email you provided. This includes the delivery of your visa once approved. 5. "Photograph *taken within the last six months" Please submit clear, proper and current photo. DO NOT use a cropped photo from your passport or modified/photoshopped photo. **IMPORTANT**

If the photograph does not reflect your current appearance, you may be refused to enter

Thailand.

6. Nationality

 DO NOT be confused about your nationality especially when you hold more than one nationality.

Notes:

- Your nationality at birth can differ from your nationality as appears on your passport.
- MAKE SURE to choose a correct type of your document of identity; Passport OR Travel Document.

Travel document holder

• If you are holding Travel document, you can fill your nationality as XXB or XXA that showed on your travel document.

IMPORTANT

- Mistake will lead to rejection of your application. Fee will NOT be refunded in any case.
- The Consulate CANNOT edit your personal details for you.

Please refer to the data in the passport you use to apply for an e-Visa.



BE CAREFUL: When filling out your visa application, please double-check all personal details, especially those automatically generated from your passport scan.

Common mistakes include, but not limited to:

- Misspelled names or mismatched names between application and passport/travel document,
- Wrong passport/travel document numbers or issuing and expiration dates,
- Mismatched date of birth or nationality.

NOTES:

- Documents indicated current location such as ID card, work/study permit, current utility bills with your name NOT maps captured from phone
- Carefully study information about the type of visa you wish to apply. Applying wrong type of visa could lead to rejection of your application. Fee will **NOT** be refunded in any case.
