Regarding the return to Thailand of Thai nationals in Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and the Kyrgyz Republic

Following the Royal Thai Embassy's Announcement No. 14/2564 dated 30 June 2021 regarding the return to Thailand of Thai nationals in Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and the Kyrgyz Republic, the Embassy wishes to inform of the new regulations regarding this issue as follows:

- 1. According to the decision of the Thailand's Centre for COVID-19 Situation Administration (CCSA) on 27 September 2021, starting from 1 October 2021 the quarantine period is reduced from 14 days (15 nights) according to the category of people as follows:
- 1.1 Those who have been vaccinated at least 14 days before arriving in Thailand must be quarantined at least 7 days (8 nights) or must enter the Phuket Sandbox Scheme for at least 7 days. The acknowledged vaccines are 1. Sinovac 2. AstraZeneca 3. Pfizer 4. Johnson&Johnson 5. Moderna 6. Sinopharm and 7. Sputnik V.
- 1.2 Those who did not obtain vaccine certificates/passports must be quarantined at least 10 days (11 nights) or must enter the Phuket Sandbox Scheme at least 10 days.
 - 2. Steps to return to Thailand for Thai nationals:

2.1 Book the flight by the airlines that are operating to Thailand;

2.2 Book in advance the Alternative Quarantine (AQ) for 7 days (8 nights) or 10 days (11 nights) upon arrival to Thailand. The list of AQ facilities and their prices can be found at https://bit.ly/3556nel

2.3 After booking of an air ticket and AQ facilities, please register for

the issuance of the Certificate of Entry (COE) at coethailand.mfa.go.th

2.4 Thai nationals must obtain (1) Certificate of Entry and (2) COVID-19 test certificate by RT-PCR method with negative result issued no longer than 72 hours before departure from the originating point of departure (in accordance with the requirement of the airlines).
