



NEW RULES ON VISA EXEMPTION

- Effective from now until 30 September 2021, passport holders of the following countries/territory may enter into the Kingdom of Thailand for tourism purposes with a period of stay up to **45 days**, without requiring a visa:

- For passport holders of other countries/territories entitled to visa exemption under bilateral agreements, please refer to the table as attached*
- Visa on Arrival scheme is further suspended until 31 March 2021.

Please note that **all foreign travellers** entering into the Kingdom of Thailand must obtain:

- Certificate of Entry (COE)
- Fit to Fly health certificate issued no more than 72 hours before departure
- Medical certificate with a laboratory result indicating that COVID-19 is not detected, using RT-PCR test, issued no more than 72 hours before departure
- Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) booking confirmation for 14 days
- Medical and travel insurance with a minimum of 100,000 USD coverage, including but not limited to COVID-19 treatment throughout the stay in Thailand
- Other required documents needed prior to arrival

Remarks

- * Passport holders of Brazil and Peru are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 90 days with Brazil and Peru.
- ** Passport holders of Vietnam and Hong Kong are entitled for tourist visa exemption scheme. Meanwhile, Thailand also holds bilateral agreements on visa exemption for holders of diplomatic, official and ordinary passports for a visit of not exceeding 30 days with Vietnam and Hong Kong.
